

Guidelines on Establishment of Institutional and Program Accreditation Steering Committee of Chung Yuan Christian University

- Article 1. The Institutional and Program Accreditation Steering Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Committee) of Chung Yuan Christian University (the University) is established to enhance the overall institutional development capacity and performance, and strengthen the promotion of institutional and program self-assessment and quality assurance.
- Article 2. The responsibilities of the Committee are as follows:
- I. Instruct the planning and promotion of institutional and program self-assessment works.
 - II. Review and appoint the institutional and program self-assessment reviewers.
 - III. Direct the execution and improvement of institutional and programming self-quality assurance efforts.
 - IV. Direct liberal education evaluation, teacher education evaluation and various project evaluations.
- Article 3. The Committee shall be composed of 7 to 11 members, of which at least three-fifths shall be off-campus members including representatives from sectors, who shall be appointed by the President. The President shall be the panel chair, and the Director of Director of Institutional Research and Sustainable Development shall be the executive secretary. The term of office of a member shall be three years in principle and may be renewed upon expiration.
- Article 4. The responsibilities of the members of the Committee are as follows:
- I. Off-campus committee members: Professors with administrative experience in higher education institutions or scholars and experts with education evaluation professions, or representatives from relevant sectors.
 - II. Faculty committee members: Full-time professors with administrative experience in the University.
- Article 5. Meetings of the Committee may only be held when more than two-thirds of the members are present; relevant personnel may be invited to attend the meetings if necessary.
- Article 6. These Guidelines are approved by the Administrative Meeting and submitted to the President for promulgation. The same applies to amendments.
