Regulations on Institutional Research Advisory Committee of Chung Yuan Christian University

- Article 1. To improve the overall quality and performance of institutional affairs and effectively promote institutional research, Chung Yuan Christian University (hereinafter referred to as the University) hereby formulates the "Institutional Research Advisory Committee of Chung Yuan Christian University" (hereinafter referred to as the Committee).
- Article 2. The Committee serves as a consulting organization that conducts institutional research with the following responsibilities:
 - I. Promote and improve works on institutional research.
 - II. Appoint administrative units to conduct works related to institutional research and information collection.
 - III. Compile proposals on institutional research on a regular basis for reference for decision-making by the President and each of the units.
 - IV. Review Chung Yuan University's annual accountability report and summary of projects on the institutional research.
 - V. Assist in formulating institutional research topics and provide analytical suggestions.
- Article 3. The members of the Committee shall compose of one to three persons, including the Director of Research and Development, the Director of Academic Affairs, the Director of Student Affairs, the Director of Career Development, the Director of Information Technology, the Director of Sustainable Development, and relevant heads and teachers appointed by the President. The panel chair of the Committee shall be appointed by the Principal, and the Director of Institutional Research and Accreditation shall be the executive secretary. The term of office of a member shall be one year and may be renewed upon expiration.
- Article 4. The Committee may hire a number of community leaders, and experts and scholars of institutional research to serve as consultants.
- Article 5. Meetings of the Committee may be officially convened upon the attendance of more than half of the members and the decisions at the meetings may be officially made with the decision-making consent of more than half of the members present.
- Article 6. These Regulations are approved by the Administrative Meeting and submitted to the President for promulgation. The same applies to amendments.
